:: THE FOUNDING OF THE ASSOCIATION ::

In 1972, Mr. Willoughby Williams, a Houston businessman, invited Phi Beta Kappa members living in the Greater Houston area to an organizational meeting held on the Rice University campus. Approximately 50 PBK alumni attended the meeting, expressed strong interest in establishing a regional Alumni Association, and elected Jenard M. Gross to serve as the group's first president. Even before the Association was officially chartered, in 1977, a scholarship program to award academic, merit-based college scholarships was begun in 1974.

:: THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS PROGRAM ::

The annual scholarship program has formed the cornerstone of the Houston Association over the past 50 years. Each spring, outstanding high school graduates from public, charter, private, and parochial schools in the greater Houston area receive scholarships funded by generous foundations, corporations, and individual donors. In the spring of every year, more than 30 Phi Beta Kappa alumni read student applications with the goal of selecting one graduating senior from each high school for an Association scholarship, over 2500 since 1974. The selections are based on academic achievement, community service, and the dedicated pursuit of excellence. Over the years these scholarship recipients have embodied the lively spirit and diversity of our great city. On April 24th we will again celebrate the spirit of Houston through a recognition of their myriad achievements, their contributions, and their great promise.
